



Follow-up of recommendations, elaboration and submission of alternative reports to treaty bodies: National training workshop for Cameroonian CSOs.

Yaoundé(31 April 2014)-The United Nations Center for Human Rights and Democracy in Central Africa (UNCHRD-CA) will organize a national workshop for Civil Society Originations on the follow-up of recommendations and elaboration and submission of shadow reports to treaty bodies from 3 to 4 April 2014 in Buea.

The two day national training workshop is aimed at reinforcing the capacity of civil society organizations working in the area of human rights in Cameroon to effectively follow up recommendations, elaborate and submit shadow reports to treaty bodies, special procedures and the Universal Periodic Review (UPR). The over 30 participants from across the country will be edified on the different human rights instruments and their follow up mechanisms, obligations of states towards ratified human rights instruments as well as techniques in the monitoring of implementation and preparation of shadow reports.

The workshop falls within the framework of the Centre's objective of strengthening the effectiveness of international human rights mechanisms and the progressive development of international human rights law and standards in Cameroon.
