

Support for the drafting of the UPR mid-term report

The Centre is providing technical support for the drafting of Gabon's mid-term report to the Universal Periodic Review and for the preparation of the Private Sector Financing Forum.

As part of the follow-up to the fourth cycle of the Universal Periodic Review (UPR), and following the acceptance of 230 out of 259 recommendations received in January 2023, the Gabonese authorities have expressed their commitment to report on progress made through the submission of a mid-term report, scheduled for January 2026.

GABON: A National Forum to Operationalize the Manifesto for Inclusive Elections

The United Nations Centre for Human Rights and Democracy in Central Africa, in partnership with the Ministry of Justice, Keeper of the Seals, in charge of Human Rights, and the Ministry of the Interior, organized a National Forum on Inclusivity in Electoral Processes from 16 to 17 June, followed by a reflection session on the operationalization of the Manifesto, held from 18 to 19 June. These activities are part of ongoing efforts to promote more inclusive and participatory elections in Gabon, ahead of the legislative and local elections scheduled for September and October 2025.
